iCom is an Erasmus Plus project which aims to compensate for the lack of formulaic language-based teaching materials by creating a handbook for teachers, an app for learners that uses all authentic sources from target languages, and an Open Educational Resource for teachers which provides practical teaching materials for formulaic language. The project is coordinated by Eurospeak (United Kingdom).

CURRENT PROGRESS

We are currently working on the iCom mobile application, led by Amaita Intercultura (Italy), and the Open Educational Resource for Formulaic Language Teaching", led by Castilla Languages (Spain). The technical development of both IOs is led by Innovation Frontiers (Greece).

APP

This will be an app that language learners can access in order to practice their communication skills and teachers can use as a supplementary activity while teaching formulaic language, building off the theories and activities they will read about in the Handbook.

The app will serve as learning material that the learner can access from home, or it can become a structured in-class learning activity given that all students have access to the internet in class.

The app will contain videos and associated quizzes.

Open Educational Resource

Teachers will be able to go on to the OER and have access to lesson plans and quizzes associated with their criteria. It will also be possible for teachers to upload materials into any category in the OER. It will be populated with at least five lessons and/or quizzes per language within the scope of the project, but it is hoped that as the OER is sustained, more and more materials will be uploaded by teachers across Europe and possibly the world.
