JUNIOR DOCUMENTS

- 1. Parental Consent Form (signed by the student's parents, stating that the local guardian is responsible for their child during their stay in the UK)
- 2. **Declaration of guardianship** (signed by the local guardian, stating that they are responsible for the student's safety and well-being outside of school hours, and that they will arrange suitable arrangements to travel to and from the school every day)
- 3. Emergency contact number for the student and guardian (in Guardians docs/ Under 18s student rules)
- 4. Pastoral Guide for U18
- 5. Student's identification documents (passport, national ID card / Visa)
- 6. Local guardian's identification documents (passport, national ID card, UK driving license / Visa)
- 7. Proof of address of the local guardian
- 8. Enrolment form





Application Procedure

- 3. Once we receive the online application form, we will send you an Offer Letter which will include the dates, price and more details of the course.
 - 4. You should confirm that all the course information and student details are correct on the Offer Letter.
 - 5. After you have confirmed everything is correct, you can make the payment.
- 6. Once we receive the full payment, we will issue the student with a Visa Letter, which will state that you have paid the total fees for the study period, and will include the dates that they are studying with us.
